

Important Information



Warning:

- This product is for towing purposes only and must only be loaded as shown in your vehicle Owner's Manual.
- This towbar is NOT to be drilled, cut, welded, or modified in any way.
- Check behind chassis rail and body panels before drilling to ensure no hazards are present.
- All load ratings shown are under the assumption your trailer has a functional braking system installed.
- When installed in positions other than the one depicted in these instructions the Tow Ball Mount may interfere or obstruct certain features of your vehicle (tailgate opening, Chassis clearance, etc.)

General:

- Before fitting this towbar read fitting instructions and check installation hardware is correct.
- Check that the towbar is suitable for the vehicle and be wary of any changes to the vehicle design that may conflict with the fitting of this towbar. (Tray, Canopy, Suspension etc.)
- After drilling, blow any filings clear, remove any burrs and treat exposed metal with a rust inhibitor.
- The high tensile fasteners supplied with this product are an integral feature to achieving the specified rating, if replacement is required ensure that fasteners of the same grade (8.8) & quality are used. Contact an authorised TAG distributer or the TAG fitment center - (07) 3208 3022 - if further information is required.

Towbar Maintenance and Care:

It is recommended, when not in use, the Tow Ball Mount assembly and class 4 Pin and Clip is stored inside the car away from moisture to prevent standing water from forming rust. Inspect to ensure, on regular basis, fasteners are torqued to the specifications below and in good condition.

Ensure that the fitting instructions are read and understood prior to fitment, Following the fitment place these instructions in the vehicle's glovebox after installation is completed.

Installation Instructions



Step 1: Remove Rear Bumper

a. Lift the tailgate.

b. Remove 2x screw covers from the taillight assembly & remove hex bolts. Pull the taillight assembly rearward & disconnect wiring harness.

- c. Remove the lower socket head screw.
- d. Remove 3x Phillips screws from the wheel arch.
- e. Remove 1x plastic scrivet from behind the wheel arch at the bottom of the bumper.
- f. Repeat steps a-e on opposite side.
- g. Remove 2x hex bolts from the rear bottom edge of the bumper.
- h. Retain all fasteners.
- i. Beginning at each wheel arch gently unclip bumper from body and remove.
- j. Disconnect the bumper harness from the inside of the bumper on PS.
- k. Set bumper aside.
- I. Remove the crash bar via 4x M8 nuts per side.
- m. Removal of the exhaust from the rear-most rubber hanger will also aid fitment but is not essential.
- n. Using an M10.5 drill, enlarge the rear-most hole on the underside of the chassis. Repeat on opposite side.

Step 2: Fit Towbar

a. Lift the bar up to the chassis and loosely fasten with M14 bolts with flat washers.

b. Insert M10x 1.25x 40 bolt with flat plate into chassis cavity and rearmost hole. Fasten loosely with M10x 1.25 nut and flat washer on underside of endplate.

c. With all bolts loose, centre the bar on the vehicle by measuring from the welded end of the towbar cross member to the crash bar mounting studs on either side.

- d. Tighten all fasteners to the torque specification on page 3.
- e. Refit the crash bar and exhaust if removed.

Step 3: Cut Bumper

Note: The towbar installer is ultimately responsible for the location & quality of the bumper cut. To avoid mistakes, please use the following measurements as a guide only. We suggest making small incremental cuts and regularly test fit the bumper to ensure an accurate and tidy appearance. The additional application of rubber pinch-weld around the cut edge ensures a neat & tidy look.

- a. Establish the centre of the bumper.
- b. Mark the cut-out 90mm wide x 130mm deep from the bottom lip of the bumper.
- c. Cut the bumper using an air hacksaw or other suitable cutting device.
- d. De-burr all cut edges.
- e. Refit bumper in reverse of steps 1a-l.



Step 4: Complete Towbar & Apply Spare Compliance Label

a. Attach TAG Hitch cover with rubber mallet carefully to prevent breaking.

b. Attach Tow ball to Ball Mount and slide hitch into towbar and secure with Pin and Clip if you are going to tow straight away, alternatively secure Ball Mount in a safe place inside your car.

c. Apply one of the compliance labels to the pillar of the driver's door. Leave the remaining label and the fitting instructions in the vehicle handbook.
