Step 1. Fit Towbar

- a. Remove scrivets and screws from wheel arches and under side rear of vehicle.
- b. Pull bumper out at sides first then rearwards. [place on stand]

Step 2. Fit Towbar & Refit Componentry

- a. Install towbar using 4 x m12 bolts and washers, nuts on wire to be inserted in subframe.
- b. With towbar as a guide drill 2 x 11mm holes through bottom seam of wheel well and secure with cup head bolts, washers, nuts, and plate supplied.
- c. Tighten all bolts to specified ratings (back page).

Step 3. Fit Ball Mount and Apply Door Sticker

- a. Attach plastic hitch surround to receiver.
- b. Insert ball mount into hitch receiver and secure with the pull pin and R-clip.
- c. Apply one of the compliance labels to the pillar of the driver's door.
- d. Leave the remaining label & the fitting instructions in the vehicle handbook.
